

Summer Camp COVID-19 Safety Protocol

These guidelines are subject to change as state or <u>university guidelines</u> change as we respond to COVID-19 conditions.

Торіс	Requirement	Notes
Is symptom screening required?	Yes. No person with a fever, cough, or other <u>COVID</u> <u>symptoms here</u> should attend the camp.	Persons who are ill should not come to camp until they are healthy. The university reserves the right to turn away campers who pose a communicable disease risk to others. Persons who are coughing, have a fever, or who generally appear ill may be turned away from the camp.
Are temperature checks required?	Regular checks are not required. Required when an individual displays symptoms of a communicable disease.	
When is testing required?	Only in cases of symptomatic campers of overnight camps.	
Will the camp be able to administer a test for a minor?	Yes. You may be asked to sign a medical release form and/or consent to follow all camp policies which include testing when required.	A participant's refusal to complete a COVID-19 test when required by the camp's guidelines may be treated as a positive test result, and they will be sent home for the remainder of the camp.
Positive Case with Camper	Parents/guardians contacted to pick up camper within 24 hours from being informed by camp. Positive results will be reported to the local public health district.	The camp will designate an isolation area for positive campers.
Close Contacts of Positive Case *Defined as someone who was indoors and less than 6' away from an infected person for a cumulative total of 15 minutes or more over a 24-hour period.	Fully vaccinated persons will be tested and follow the subsequent steps. Non-fully-vaccinated persons will be sent home from the camp to quarantine for 5 days.	Persons who have had confirmed COVID-19 case within 90 days are not required to quarantine if proof of a positive viral test can be provided.
Refunds	No reimbursements will be made.	



By participating in the camp, the participant agrees to comply with all camp rules, procedures, and guidelines, including but not limited to the camp's COVID-19 guidelines. This means, for example, that by participating in the camp, the participant is agreeing to complete a COVID-19 test administered by camp personnel when required by the camp's guidelines. A participant's refusal to complete a COVID-19 test when required by the camp's guidelines may be treated as a positive test result.

If these guidelines change between the signing of the agreement and the time of the event, the prevailing local guidance at the time of the event will be followed. Campus and local guidance on mask wearing at the time of the event will be followed.
